The meeting was called to order by President Aaron and opened with prayer led by Pastor Eckstein.

Treasurer's Report: No report Pastor's Report: Member changes, Will Ziegler to Zion in Edgeley, ND. Motion made and seconded to approve

the change. Motion carried. Advent services will be on Wednesday, Dec. 7. Dec. 14 and Dec. 21 at 7:00 p.m. Christmas Eve service will be on 12/24 at 5:00 p.m. There will be one service on Dec. 25th at 10:30 a.m. as well as one service on 1/1/23. The 8:00 a.m. service will resume on January 8 th . Pastor and family will be on vacation from December 26 th through January 5 th . Pastor is now publishing a "His Word is Truth" article twice per month in the Jamestown Sun. They will be published on the second and fourth Saturday paper.

There were several DVD players not being used at the time and after discussion a motion was made and seconded to donate these items to Orphan Grain to be sent to places that could use them. Motion carried.

The next meeting will be Monday, January 9th at 8:00 p.m.
